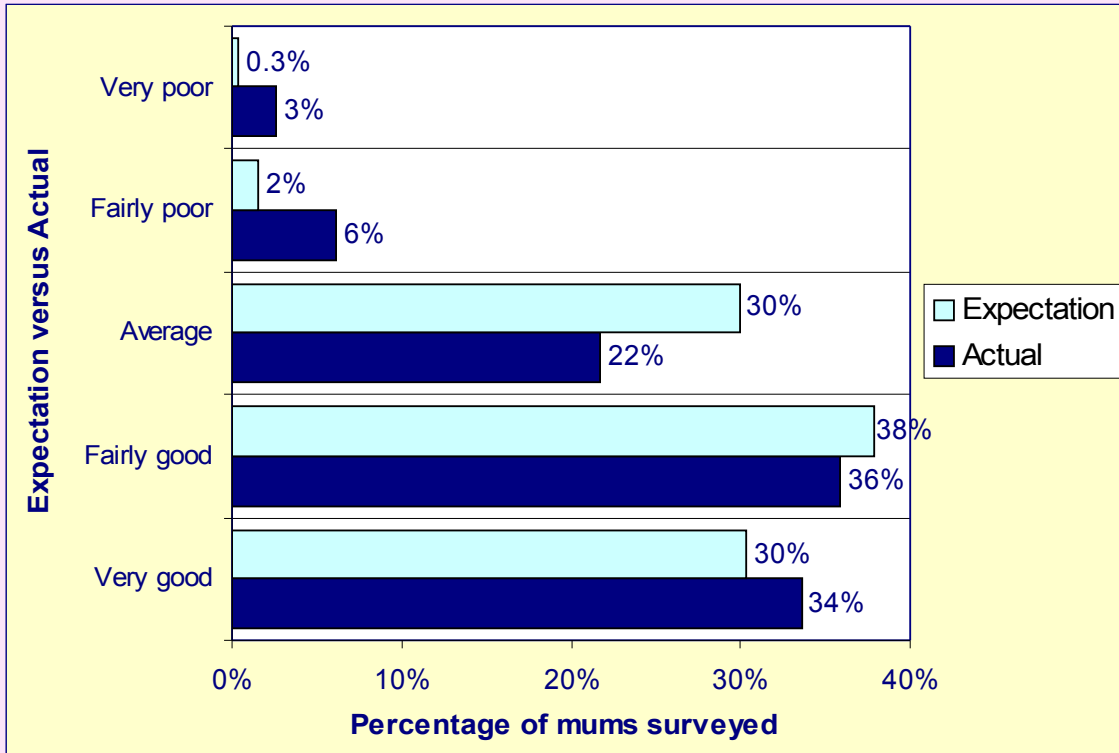


Survey Question:

“Following the birth of your baby do you expect the level of support from Healthcare professionals (e.g. Midwives, Health Visitors, etc) to be:”

compared with

“Following the birth of your baby was the level of support from Healthcare professionals (e.g. Midwives, Health Visitors, etc):”



Information about the survey:

- 7 in 10 mums report that support from Healthcare professionals, following the birth of their baby, is good.
- The level of support expected from the Healthcare Profession by pregnant women is matched by that actually received in reality.
- However, nearly 1 in 10 women say that the support they received from Healthcare professionals was poor.
